



Shorter keywords also come before longer ones. The only modification to this pattern is that entries with leading quote characters are sorted as if they didn't.

Background Notes: Edwards family-who ran the Foresters' Arms from 1878 to 1959: Jack, Joan and Keith ("Joker") are children of Joseph Alfred Edwards (1872-1928) whose mother was Fanny Sheppard (then Mrs Edwards, then Mrs Trail). Fanny's sister was Jack's (great) Aunt Tottie. Joseph's parents lived in Glenhuntly. Their other children were George Evelyn (Jack's Uncle Eve), Clara, and Harriet (Hattie Mrs Will Blackburn) Edwards, and later a beloved half-brother, Archibald Claude Trail (Uncle Arch, who married Myrtle). Jack Edwards Reserve is on the north side of the railway line, between Huntingdale and Oakleigh (Melway 69 H9).
